Anyone participating in the “VANAS Teachers’ Conference” at Colegio Internacional de Caracas has an opportunity to obtain two semester graduate credits from Buffalo State, SUNY. The cost of the credit is \$170.00 U.S. dollars. The course will be identified as **EDU 594: Successful Strategies for the American/International School Educator.**

There are only two course requirements:

- B. Complete a paper (one-three pages) that discusses applications of those sessions to your current teaching and/or administrative assignment. Papers must be completed and submitted by May 01, 2007.

1. A brief, one-page registration form to the address or fax number below.
2. A photocopy of your diploma or transcript verifying the receipt of your undergraduate degree if you do not have one on file in our office. Your degree must be the equivalent of a United States Bachelor’s degree.
3. A personal check, certified check, traveler’s check or money order (sorry, no credit cards) for \$170.00 made payable to “**THE RESEARCH FOUNDATION OF SUNY**”.
